Spring Keystone Examinations are right around the corner. The testing window begins May 13, 2019. Keystone Exams are administered in the areas of English Literature, Algebra I, and Biology. The purpose of these tests is to provide a measure of performance for both our students and our school, and to fulfill Pennsylvania's responsibility under Chapter 4 Regulations and federal accountability requirements. Remediation classes will be mandatory for non-proficient students.

The Spring Keystone Exams will be administered to the following students:

- Students who are currently enrolled in Algebra I, Grade 10 English, and/or Biology.
- Students who did not receive a score of proficient or advanced on previous Keystone Exams (and have received remediation) or students who have not taken all three Keystone Exams (excluding freshmen).

The Spring Keystone Exams will be administered during the following dates and times:

- Literature – May 13, 2019 (8:00-10:10 a.m. and 12:30-2:40 p.m.)
- Algebra – May 16, 2019 (8:00-10:10 a.m. and 12:30-2:40 p.m.)
- Biology– May 17, 2019 (8:00-10:10 a.m. and 12:30-2:40 p.m.)
- Makeups – May 20, 21, and 22, 2019 (Times TBA)

Please make sure that your child is well rested, has eaten a healthy breakfast, and is on time to school during the testing window.

As soon as the scores are received, they will be shared with you. We will also share with you any necessary remediation plans for students who did not score proficient or advanced. Should you have any questions concerning the assessments, please contact the school at 717-732-8450.
