Winter Keystone Examinations are right around the corner. Keystone Exams are administered in the areas of English Literature, Algebra I, and Biology. Beginning with the class of 2022, students must demonstrate proficiency on all Keystone Exams as a graduation requirement. Remediation classes will be mandatory for non-proficient students.

- Algebra – January 9, 2019 (8:00-10:10 a.m. and 12:30-2:40 p.m.)
- Biology – January 10, 2019 (8:00-10:10 a.m. and 12:30-2:40 p.m.)
- Makeups – January 14-17, 2019 (Times TBA)

Please make sure that your child is well rested, has eaten a healthy breakfast, and is on time to school during the testing window.
