# <u>Creative Writing</u> <u>Audition Information</u>



## The Audition Process:

The Creative Writing Program requires a portfolio. You may provide a digital portfolio shared to <a href="mailto:kwerner@students.casa-arts.org">kwerner@students.casa-arts.org</a> OR you may print your portfolio and bring it with you the day of the audition.

#### Your portfolio must include the following:

- A digital portfolio file should be named: "Your Last Name-PORTFOLIO" (e.g., smith-portfolio).
- A printed portfolio should include a title page with your full name.
- Samples must be typed in Times New Roman, 12-point font, and double-spaced.
- A personal statement of no more than one page answering the question, "Why do you want to be a Creative Writer at CASA?"
- One piece of fiction –a complete story with a beginning, middle, and end (not to exceed 4 pages, double-spaced).
- Two to Three pieces of poetry.
- One piece of nonfiction this could be a memoir, biography/autobiography, essay, or journalism.

### Live Group Audition

<b>Audition Day</b>
(90 minutes)

You will participate in a one-hour creative writing class, which will include both collaborative and independent writing activities.

Following the class, you will complete a brief written reflection and participate in a short interview focusing on the work created during the audition and the pieces submitted in your pre-screening portfolio.

## Important Things to Know:

- Portfolios must include all required elements to be considered.
- Proofreading is essential: scores will be greatly reduced for significant errors in spelling, punctuation, grammar, and usage. Have someone read your portfolio and give you feedback. All writers revise. All writers edit.
- The application process is incredibly competitive. If this is truly your passion and you are not accepted into the program this year, please apply again next year.
