Film and Media Arts Audition Information



The Requirements

The Film and Media Arts Program requires the submission of an original film or a selection of media artworks with the online application in order to be invited to a live review and audition.

• An <u>original film</u>, three-five minutes in length. Films should be narrative (fictional), and tell a story. Please, no "music videos" unless original music is created. Students must film all original material themselves. Films must include multiple shots and edited into a sequence.

Films should begin with a title screen and end with credits.

OR

• <u>8-10 media artworks</u> (in the same medium or a combination) of the following acceptable mediums: Digital photo collage, 3D rendered image/video, Vector-graphic design, Audio production (Documentary or Podcast style), Photography

Note: If students chose to submit the media art component they will still be evaluated on use of camera equipment during the audition, and story-based filmmaking will be a central component of the class curriculum during the school year.

The Audition/Interview

Students will complete the following:

- Please bring the audition film or media artworks on a flash drive or a link to it on YouTube or Vimeo.
- A brief interview
- Filming and editing assessments of skill level using school equipment.
- Film & media art theory questionnaire.
- Please bring the audition film or media artworks on a flash drive or a link to it on YouTube or Vimeo.
