	the Board of Trustees of Charter School who is appointed to preside al disciplinary hearing shall:
1.	Be impartial, disinterested and objective, including but not limited to:
	a. Having no financial or personal interest in the outcome of the hearing; and
	b. Having no prior involvement with the child, whether personally or professionally;
2.	Have the ability to communicate effectively;
3.	Understand the role of the hearing officer in formal disciplinary proceedings;
4.	Be familiar with federal and Pennsylvania law regarding discipline of both regular education students and special education students;
5.	Understand school policies and the School Student Code of Conduct as they relate to discipline;
6.	Have the ability to objectively analyze the evidence presented by all flllies in accordance with federal and Pennsylvania law, as well as relevant policies, to develop a recommendation for discipline that will be presented to the Board of Trustees;

 7. Recite an Oath of Office reflecting their acceptance of the responsibilities of their role. <u>OATH FOR HEARING OFFICERS</u> "I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support, obey and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of this Commonwealth, and that I will discharge the duties as a duly appointed expulsion hearing officer with fidelity."
